Check-In / Check-Out:

Check-in time is 3:00 p.m. local time. Check-out time is 11:00 a.m. local time. Anyone checking out after 11:00 a.m. local time may incur late charges. A sufficient morning break will occur to permit check out.

Directions to National Harbor:

From Washington, DC:

- Take I-295 South for approximately 5.5 miles
- Take National Harbor Exit 1B

From Maryland:

- Merge onto I-495 / I-95 Capital Beltway - Inner Loop
- The lanes will divide after you pass Exit 4. Stay in the right-hand lanes in order to take the "Local Lanes"
- Take National Harbor Exit 2A

From Virginia:

- Merge onto I-495 / I-95 Capital Beltway - Outer Loop
- As you approach the Woodrow Wilson Bridge, stay in the right-hand lanes in order to take the "Local Lanes"
- Cross the Woodrow Wilson Bridge
- Take National Harbor Exit 2A
